For the Sake of the Faith

Scripture: Titus 1:1-4

Main Point: We are servants of a faithful God, entrusted with an eternal message, for an unstoppable mission.

We are servants... // v. 1, 4

Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

Being a servant or disciple of Christ means sometimes asking: What does God love that I'm tempted to hate, and what does God hate that I'm tempted to love?

"I believe the doctrine of election, because I am quite certain that, if God had not chosen me, I should never have chosen Him; and I am sure He chose me before I was born, or else He never would have chosen me afterwards; and He must have elected me for reasons unknown to me, for I never could find in myself why He should have looked upon me with special love. So I am forced to accept that great Biblical doctrine." –Charles Spurgeon

...entrusted with an eternal message,... // v. 3
